The CLIMA Fund is a collaboration among Global Greengrants Fund, Grassroots International, Thousand Currents, and Urgent Action Fund for Feminist Action. The CLIMA Fund offers a way for large funders to efficiently and effectively reach grassroots work around the globe. We holistically support climate movement-building, from rapid response for environmental defenders to long-term partnership and support to social movements.

The CLIMA Fund collaborative has:

- over **130 years** of collective experience funding grassroots movements
- A total budget of **>\$70M**
- Given over **25,000 grants**
- Worked in **168 countries**

We have raised **\$37M** for grassroots groups. We have reached over **600 funders** with our programming, and aim to influence climate and environmental funders to shift investments towards grassroots movements. Our grants are often the primary support for groups advancing visions to minimize warming on a time scale relevant to the crisis worldwide.

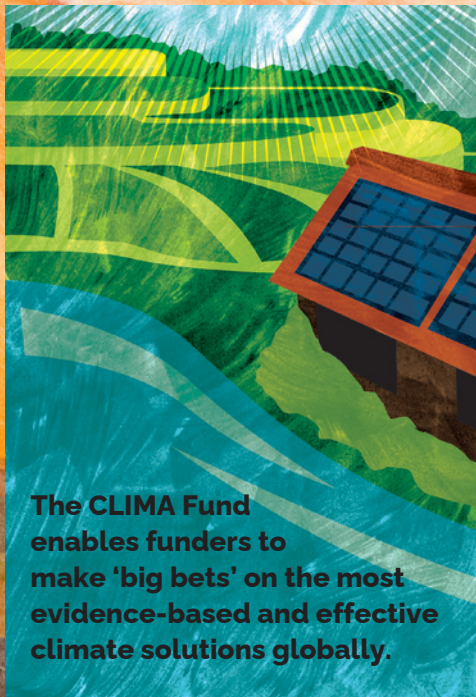

WHY FUND CLIMA?



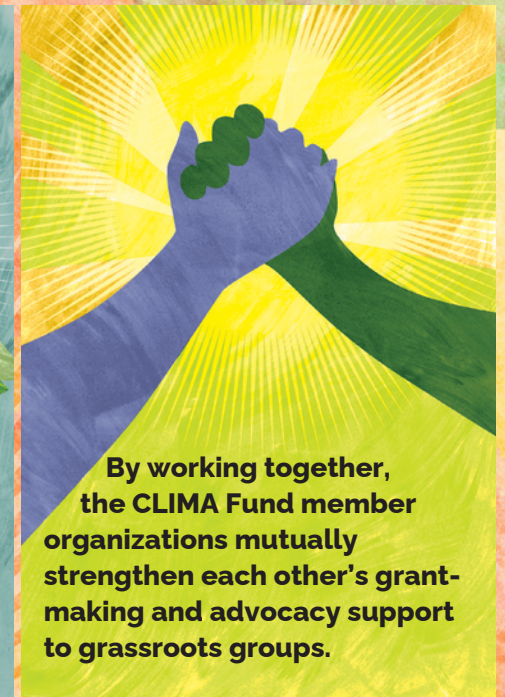
The CLIMA Fund enables funders to make 'big bets' on the most evidence-based and effective climate solutions globally.
